

Maurice and Gerda LaPierre Our Missionaries in Haiti

Dear Pastor Veach and First Bible Church:



As the Lord is with me, and I am still learning, I love Him forever. By His grace, I will always be prompt to His calling. Dear friend pastor Veach, my prayers are always with you and yours including your whole church, which is my church. I sent a letter to pastor Ryman before to help him understand the situation here, in Haiti. I let him know that an angel named Veach with the brethren came here and become a big blessing from the Lord. And, another angel named Nick Baert came and become another blessing from the Lord. He is now the deputy spokes-brother for Lacaye Mission to help raise the support for it. I might have only now to receive angels from the churches in America, if it is for the work to establish and to grow. There is another group of fifteen from Pastor Sowell, in Toledo Ohio, that has called me for next July. This is just the beginning dear friend; that is why I am praying for a Nissan van, which can carry twenty people. We are in need of a good performing laptop also. We just finish [translating] the New Testament. We have a long way to go in our work, unless our Lord comes now, which would be far better.

Concerning the land, it is two hectares, it is huge. After building a church, a good few things can be built there to establish a mission with an educative program; they need a Christian sound doctrine Bible school, without which the country will always be doomed for hell. The mentality of the people will have to change; no government will be able to do so. The power of God can do it. The owner of the land gives us favor, and said that we can start building the church, if we can give him the first fifty thousand dollars, into which ten thousand already deposited, then, we'll give him the rest as the work goes. I met Mr Fatal before, and I ran away from him and never called him back, and it was only because I thought I would never be able to find hundred fifty thousand dollars to pay for his land. I had hope, but in small things since I saw my poverty and being unable to do what the Lord put in my heart to do, then, I pray for Christ return instead, that with good will, and faithfulness, and a fixed heart that I may not lose anything in heaven.

Now just as the Lord used you that I have my wife and my son, He also will let others share this vision that He gave me when I was living in America. The country is dead but we have the resurrected vision. Having a mission from the Lord required a lot of patience while the means are coming. You and I have a different bond, without your support I could not stay in Haiti. You helped greatly in my staying here. The mission also has to be established. Each mission has a different approach, different attitude, different people but the same abundant riches of Christ. That God may rule all hearts, which will avenge on their own disobediences to God when they are transforming to the image of Christ. That all may say, Amen! Glory to God. (Yes next month, May, will be fine to come.)
